Passport and visa fees, border taxes when applicable, items not listed on standard group menus, **mineral water, tea, coffee, after meal beverages, personal expenses** (i.e. laundry, valet service, cabs, telephone calls, postage, etc.), tips to drivers, guides, tour escorts and other services not indicated above.

### **Tipping:**

Tour guide \$6 per person per touring day. Driver: \$3 per person per touring day. Porter: 0.5\$ per bag per person. Wait staff: \$1.50 per person (dinner only). Chamber maid: \$1.00 per person per day (\$11 to \$12 per day).
